Fee Increase

Our fees for 3 & 4 year olds are now in line with the government funding, this fee reflects the child staff ratios of one staff member to every 8 children. A pre-school learning alliance study already shows that there is still a shortfall in funding overall.

The government funded rate for 2 year olds is at present £4.85, our fee is £4.30 which does not reflect the child to staff ratio of 1 staff for every 4 children.

Within the last two years there have been six pre-schools in the local area which have been forced to close.

The government has now bought in the living wage, plus pensions are also to be introduced, we have also incurred a fee increase in rent for the hall.

In order for our community, charity run preschool to remain open we will be increasing our fees for all two year olds.

An increase to £4.80 an hour from April 2016 will be applied.

If you have any queries or questions about the increase PLEASE speak to a member of staff or committee, thank you.

(The Pre-school will continue to review our fees on a regular basis)
