Parent Questionnaire

Thank you to all who responded to our Questionnaire, a few queries have been raised.

Invoices; our invoices are generated per half term by the assistant treasurer, we are unable to do monthly invoices as this is not cost or time effective as we only run in term time. If you would like more information please speak to Louise.
